

## Charging fees / policy

Chrissy's Childcare is open 0700 – 1800 5 days a week. Funding can be used term time, or it can be stretched to work around family's needs. Flexibility is available please ask for more information.

Funding offered for working families, from age 9 months (eligible criteria). Outside funding allocation is charged at £6.50 an hour.

The working families funding requires the parent to apply for a code on the government website. A place will only be offered once you have given Chrissy's Childcare the code and the code has been verified. The parent would need to confirm the code every 3 months otherwise they will fall into a grace period and therefore the funding will stop. Some 2 years old may be entitled to 15 hours per week if they are in receipt of additional support, Chrissy will check eligibility for you. All 3 & 4 year olds are entitled to 15 hours per week no matter their circumstances, the term after their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday. Please speak to Chrissy to confirm eligibility.

Parents will sign the funding agreement, and 4 week's notice is required if they wish to leave the setting or if Chrissy's Childcare terminates the agreement. Chrissy's Childcare has no registration fee for those on early years funding or paying private. Late pick-up charges will be £10 per 15 minutes late.

If you wish to pay for additional hours, this is charged at £6.50 per hour.

This policy will be reviewed every 6 months, and the hourly rate (for extra hours) will be reviewed yearly.

## Additional information

- How do meals work – Meals can be provided by our setting at an extra charge of £4.50. However, you can opt out of this, and parents can provide a packed lunch
- How do consumables work (e.g. nappies/wipes) parents provide nappies and wipes.
- If any trips are arranged, we will discuss this with parents (this may require a small additional fee) but will be optional to attend.
